Rules: The 2005-2007 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, will govern the racing except as they are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. The series is designated Category A.

Eligibility requirements: All yachts that have an overall length of at least 20 feet and weigh in excess of 750 lbs. empty, with a valid PHRF Certificate. The vessel must be owned and driven by a member, in good standing, of the Encinal Yacht Club. The crew of any competing yacht must be composed of a minimum of 1/3 Encinal Yacht Club members in good standing. All yachts must comply with the U.S. Coast Guard equipment requirements for recreational vessels including proper navigation lights.

Registration: Completed Entry Form with current PHRF Certificate, must be received by the Encinal Yacht Club office no later than 5:00 p.m. September 29th, 2007. Any entries after this time are late and will require a late entry fee of \$10.

Schedule of Race: The race is scheduled on September 30th, 2007. First Warning signal will be made at 12:55 weather permitting.

Racing Area: The start will be between the mouth of the Alameda/ Oakland Estuary and Yerba Buena Island. The race will proceed to round Treasure Island to port or starboard, then down the Alameda/Oakland Estuary to finish at the Encinal Yacht Club docks.

Sailing Instructions: Will be available no later than September 29th, 2007 by 8:00 p.m. at EYC and a copy will be posted on the EYC web page [www.encinal.org](http://www.encinal.org). Amendments will be posted on [www.encinal.org](http://www.encinal.org) and at EYC by 5pm the Friday before the race.

Scoring: The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply. TIME ON TIME handicapping system will be used. Tentative Results will be posted no later than 90 minutes of the last boat to finish.
