## “Spring Twilight Series 2007”

Spring Friday Night Series – April 13, April 27, May 11, June 1 & June 15

**Rules:** The Current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of one-design classes, will govern the racing except as they are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. The series is designated Category A.

**Classes Invited:** Boats with valid PHRF certificates and one-design classes. One Design classes will be five or more boats. On April 11th, if a one-design class does not fulfill the 5-boat minimum, they will be scored in the appropriate handicap class. All One-Design Classes are encouraged to drive up participation- we look forward to more One Design starts!

**Eligibility requirements:** Sailboats that have an overall length of at least 19 feet with a valid PHRF Certificate. All yachts must comply with the U.S. Coast Guard equipment requirements for recreational vessels including proper navigation lights.

**Registration:** Completed Entry Form, current PHRF Certificate, and fees must be received by the Encinal Yacht Club office no later than 5:00 p.m. April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2007. Any entries after this time are late and will require a late entry fee of \$10.

Spring Series Fee: \$45.00 or \$75 for both Spring and Summer Twilight Series (check payable to: EYC)

Spring Series, with Late Fee, \$55 or \$85 for both Spring & Summer Twilight Series.

**Racing Area:** The Oakland Estuary

**Sailing Instructions:** Will be available at EYC and the EYC web page ([www.encinal.org](http://www.encinal.org)) on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2007 by 8:00 p.m. **Amendments** will be posted on [www.encinal.org](http://www.encinal.org) and at EYC by 5pm the Thursday before the race.

**Scoring:** The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply. Five races are scheduled, of which 4 races shall be completed to constitute a series.

**PHRF Scoring:** TIME ON TIME handicapping system will be used. A 3 second per mile advantage will be given to any boat that includes one or more EYC Junior sailors who must be shown to the RC prior to each start.

**Trophies:** Series trophies will be awarded at Encinal Yacht Club June 15<sup>th</sup> as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place in all divisions with 6 or more boats. Divisions with less than 6 boats will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place.

**Results:** After each race the race results will be posted in the EYC Bar no later than 90 minutes after the last boat finishes.

**The Encinal Yacht Club will offer three different ways to enjoy your evening after the race:**

**a) You may enjoy a sit-down full service dinner in our dining room**

**b) You may order from the bar menu and enjoy your meal on our upper deck or bar / lounge area**

**c) You may purchase and cook your own chicken breast, hamburger or hotdog on our BBQ's on the upper deck. We will supply all the fixing's.**

**Also, when possible, a video playback of the race will be shown on the new 62" TV in the bar.**
