

EYC High School Sailing 2017-18 Roles and Responsibilities Form

The Encinal Yacht Club responsibilities:

- Create a safe, fun and vibrant High School sailing program, supporting multiple schools of varying levels of development
- Help our teams understand and adhere to PCISA and NorCal rules and guidelines
- Provide leadership and administrative support through its Junior Sailing Program and its Parent Coordinators
- Provide and maintain sailboats and support boats in good condition.
- Hire and supervise qualified coaches.
- NOTE: Not included in the EYC or Coach responsibilities is the travel planning and organizational requirements related to regatta participation by the sailors. EYC will be responsible for the coach's travel. The Coaches and Director are happy to offer advice and assistance in this regard, but the ultimate responsibility rests with the sailor and their family/team.

The Director and the Coaches Responsibilities:

- Provide the highest standards of instruction and example for the sailors
- Treat each sailor with respect and attention, without regard for personal preference or prejudice and promote teamwork and individual growth
- Provide direction and discipline at all times to ensure the safety of the sailors.
- Ensure that all equipment and facilities are in as good condition as possible for the sailors' use.
- Arrange regatta organization as it relates to team lineups, who's towing, and coaching.
- Have final say on team lineup decisions for teams.

The Sailors Responsibilities:

- Arrive and be ready to sail on time when practice or competition begins.
- Be free of drugs and alcohol. Anyone caught using drugs or alcohol on the premises or at any regatta, including off the water will be subject to discipline by the director and EYC, including suspension or expulsion from the team..
- Practice and regatta spaces shall be left as clean if not cleaner than originally found.
- Be available to load and unload boats when necessary for their team.
- Treat their teammates, parents, coaches and competitors with respect. You represent your High School and EYC appropriately at all times during practice and in competition.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, physical/verbal aggression, harassment, theft, or abusive behavior will not be tolerated and will be subject to discipline including suspension or expulsion from the team.
- Treat all Club equipment and facilities with care and respect; accept financial liability if damage incurred is the result of sailor negligence

The Parents Responsibilities:

- Provide whatever volunteer support they can within their means- loading boats, towing, transportation and regatta help.
- Be willing to be the parent chaperone for their team and provide whatever is necessary in this area.
- Support the sailors with guidance and logistical support and transportation necessary to enable them to compete. Acknowledge and support the coach's decisions, refraining from undermining the authority of the Coaches and Club

Team Parent Coordinator Responsibilities:

- Interface with their High School's athletic department or administration, as needed
- Coordinate regatta participation, logistics and parent chaperone for their HS at each regatta
- Handle regular communications with their team members, including the recruitment of new team members.
- Facilitate split-teaming where needed (working with the EYC Junior Sailing Director, other team Parent Coordinators and EYC Overall HS Sailing Parent Coordinators)
- Work with Director and Team Captain(s) on event participation and lineup decisions, etc
