## *Welcome to Winter and Spring Sailing!*

It's hard to believe that the 2017 sailing season has come to a close — Summer and Fall sailing has passed us by in a flash, probably because we've been hard at work to keep up our mission of having as much fun on the water as we can, as often as we can! A truly exceptional group of young sailors makes up our High School and Race teams and has represented EYC with pride as they completed a very successful end to the 2016-2017 high school season, attended national events in the C420, Laser, and Opti, achieved overall victory in the 2017 Summer BAYS series, and leapt into the 2017-2018 high school season and 2018 Winter BAYS series this fall.

Our High School teams were rewarded for their hard work as they finished up the 2016-2017 Pacific Coast Inter-Scholastic Sailing Association (PCISA) season in April at the Gold Fleet Pacific Coast Championship, hosted at Cabrillo Beach YC. Three teams were invited to participate, and two of them finished in the top ten overall. Needless to say, all 70 sailors from our 14 high school teams were eager to jump into the new season at full speed in September, attending more challenging events whenever possible. So far this season our teams have had a strong presence at all five of the NorCal (regional level) and PCISA (district level) CFJ regattas and have sent sailors to both the PCISA Singlehanded Pacific Coast Championship (sailed in Laser Full and Radial), hosted by the U.S. Sailing Center - Long Beach, and the PCISA Keelboat Challenge (sailed in J22s), hosted by the San Diego Yacht Club. We're so proud of how our sailors have conducted themselves and we can't wait to see what they'll do with the remainder of their season in 2018 as they consider what kind of dividends result from hard work and consistency.

Several Race Team members of our C420, Laser, and Opti teams attended national events like the Laser North American Championship (Royal Vancouver Yacht Club), Laser U.S. Nationals (Tahoe Yacht Club), Bemis and Smythe (Doublehanded and Singlehanded U.S. Jr. Championships, respectively) Regattas at Toms River Yacht Club in NJ, and the Opti West Coast and Pacific Coast Championships (Santa Barbara and San Francisco YCs, respectively). Sailors from all of our race team fleets should be filled with pride from their collective performance during our local Bay Area Youth Sailing (BAYS) series. We attended the five Summer events — Richmond, EYC, PYSF, SFYC, and Treasure Island — and our sailors put in the work and reaped the rewards, with EYC teams taking home the series trophies in all four fleets: Paul Cayard Perpetual (C420), John Kosteki Perpetual (Opti), Pam Healy Perpetual (Laser Radial), and CFJ Perpetual. Their timing couldn't be better - for the first time, the Winter BAYS series will include all four fleets, instead of restricting it to the Opti fleets only as has been the case for several years. We've already competed in the first two events of the 2018 Winter BAYS series at St Francis YC and SFYC, and can't wait to host the third event here in February!

Our program is extremely grateful for the support of the Club and its members, and we're thrilled to be able to represent such a fine group of people when we attend regattas. Please feel free to stop by if you see us around the yard.

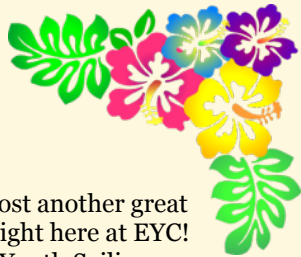
