

## NOTICE OF RACE

### Santana 22 Nationals

July 30, 31, and Aug 1, 2010

*Encinal Yacht Club, Alameda, CA*

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The Santana 22 Nationals be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The rules of the Santana 22 One Design Class will apply.
- 1.3 Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the SIs.
- 1.4 By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organizing authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

#### 2. COURSES AND LOCATION

Races shall be sailed in San Francisco Bay. The start finish line will be located approximately 0.5 miles west of the end of the Berkeley Pier. Courses will be windward-leeward, using inflatable temporary marks.

3. **ADVERTISING** – Shall be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code, and the relevant class rules.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 4.1 AGE  
Applicants of all ages are eligible
- 4.2 CLASS ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP  
Competing Boats must be members of their respective class association.

## 5. BOATS/MEASUREMENT

5.1 Boat class: (Santana 22) conforming to the Santana 22 One design class rules, will be used for this event.

5.2 Each competitor will be responsible for their boats being in compliance with the class rules.

6. **FEES** - The entry fee for all classes is \$ **60** per boat

## 7. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

**Friday July 30** Registration & check-in, (10:00 hrs)

Optional Practice Race (First Gun at 13:00 hrs)

**Saturday July 31** Three races schedule (First Gun at 11:00 hrs)

**Sunday Aug 1** Two races schedule (First Gun at 11:00 hrs)

Awards presentation: (16:00 hrs. Pending completion of regatta and any protests filed for this event.)

8. **ADVANCE REGISTRATION** - Competitors shall register in advance by completing the Event Registration Form found on [www.encinal.org](http://www.encinal.org) or at the Encinal Yacht Club Office. Entry deadline is July 30, 12:00 hrs.

9. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** - The sailing instructions will be available at registration and on the web at: [www.encinal.org](http://www.encinal.org) .

10. **SCORING** - A maximum of **5** races are scheduled, of which **2** shall be completed to constitute a series. There will be no throw outs for this series.

11. **SAFETY** - A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee vessel before leaving the course, or when that is impossible, notify the Encinal Yacht Club immediately after arrival ashore.

## 12. DISCIPLINE

12.1 All competitors are expected to maintain the highest level of conduct throughout the entire event. When the Protest Committee, from its own observation or a report received from any source believes that a competitor may have committed a breach of a rule, good manners, or sportsmanship, or may have brought the sport into disrepute, it may call a hearing. After a proper hearing the penalty may range from a reprimand to dismissal from the regatta and additional action may be taken under RRS 69.

12.2 Hearings will be held generally in accordance with the recommendations of Appendix M5 of the RRS.

13. **PRIZES** – Trophies will be awarded to competitors placing first through third.

14. **Water Access**

Encinal Yacht Club has a 3 Ton hoist available to competitors to launch their boats. There is a public ramp located approximately ¼ mile from the club. If you plan on storing your trailer at the Encinal Yacht Club for this event, contact: Tony Shaffer (Regatta Chair) to reserve a parking location.
