1 Rules:

1.1 The race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the rules of one-design classes except as they are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2 Eligibility:

2.1 Boats having an overall length of at least 20 feet and a minimum weight of 750 pounds empty, with valid PHRF certificate, and one-design classes. All yachts must comply with the U.S. Coast Guard equipment requirements for recreational vessels including proper navigation lights.

3 Registration:

3.1 Eligible boats may register through a link on EYC's site at: <u>www.jibeset.net</u>.

4 Schedule of Race:

4.1 First warning signal will be at 11:30 am

5 Race Course:

5.1 YRA 10 (app. 1/2 nm west of end of Berkeley Pier – Alcatraz Island – YRA 8 (1 nm east of Point Blunt) – Treasure Island – Oakland Estuary – Encinal Yacht Club.

6 Sailing Instructions:

6.1 Will be available Mar 31, 2018 on the EYC web site <u>www.encinal.org</u>. Addendums, including divisions, will be posted on www.encinal.org and at EYC by .

7 Scoring:

- 7.1 The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply.
- 7.2 PHRF Scoring: Time on time handicapping system will be used.

8 Trophies:

8.1 Two trophies will be awarded at EYC after the race.
The Overall Winner will receive the Ron Byrne Memorial Trophy
The Winning Encinal Yacht Club Member, will receive the Estuary Cup
